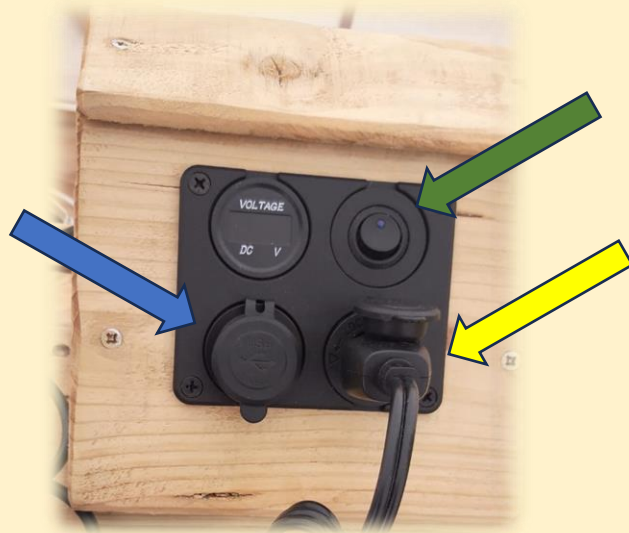


Ffos Wilkin Instruction Sheet

Tent Power



There is a small power unit on the coffee table.

This supplies power to the TV (yellow arrow) and has some USB sockets for charging devices (blue arrow).

To switch on flick the switch on the top right (green arrow).

Voltage display should illuminate to show there is power.

The TV and USB slots can now be used.

Switch off when not in use to conserve battery power.

The red power convertor behind the TV is only rated for the TV and cannot be used for anything else.

Wifi on the Pitch

To connect search wifi signals for 'FfosWilkinGlamping'. The password is ilove2glamp!

Food Caddy



Any unwanted food is to be placed in the food caddy.

Used Oil Recycling



Small amounts of used cooking oil can wipe up with kitchen roll and place in the food caddy. Any large amount can be poured into the provided container.

Hot Water Boiler

The hot water used in the kitchen and bathroom is heated by an outdoor gas camping boiler.

If the water goes cold whilst being used switch off the taps for a few seconds and try again. If after several attempts the water is still cold then the gas bottle may need changing. Contact us for assistance.

Lighting

To conserve battery power the bathroom light is motion activated. At dusk the sensor will detect movement and switch on for a few minutes. The light will stay on if there is movement.

The tent lamps are permanently powered from the solar batteries and switched on via the local lamp rocker switch.

The kitchen light is solar and battery powered and is switched on via the pull cord near the light

TV & Netflix

To use the TV first switch on the power unit on the coffee table. The TV will automatically power up and 'BUSH' will be displayed on the screen for a moment. The

TV will then go into 'Stand By' with the small red LED illuminated at the bottom of the screen. You can then switch on the TV by the red power button on the remote control.

The TV is connected to the pitch wifi. There are no user accounts connected to Netflix etc. If you want to use these services, you will have to enter your own details.

Picnic Table Sun Umbrella

The umbrella needs to be lowered and covered when not in use in case of high winds or rain.

Open air / Outdoor Kitchen

Closing the kitchen shutters does give a lot of rain protection but not 100%.

In case of unforeseen rain do not leave any items out that do not appreciate getting wet. Remember wildlife is always on the hunt for easy food. Animals may also come and investigate the area when you're not around. Closed shutters will protect your glamping treats!
